Safety on the Streets

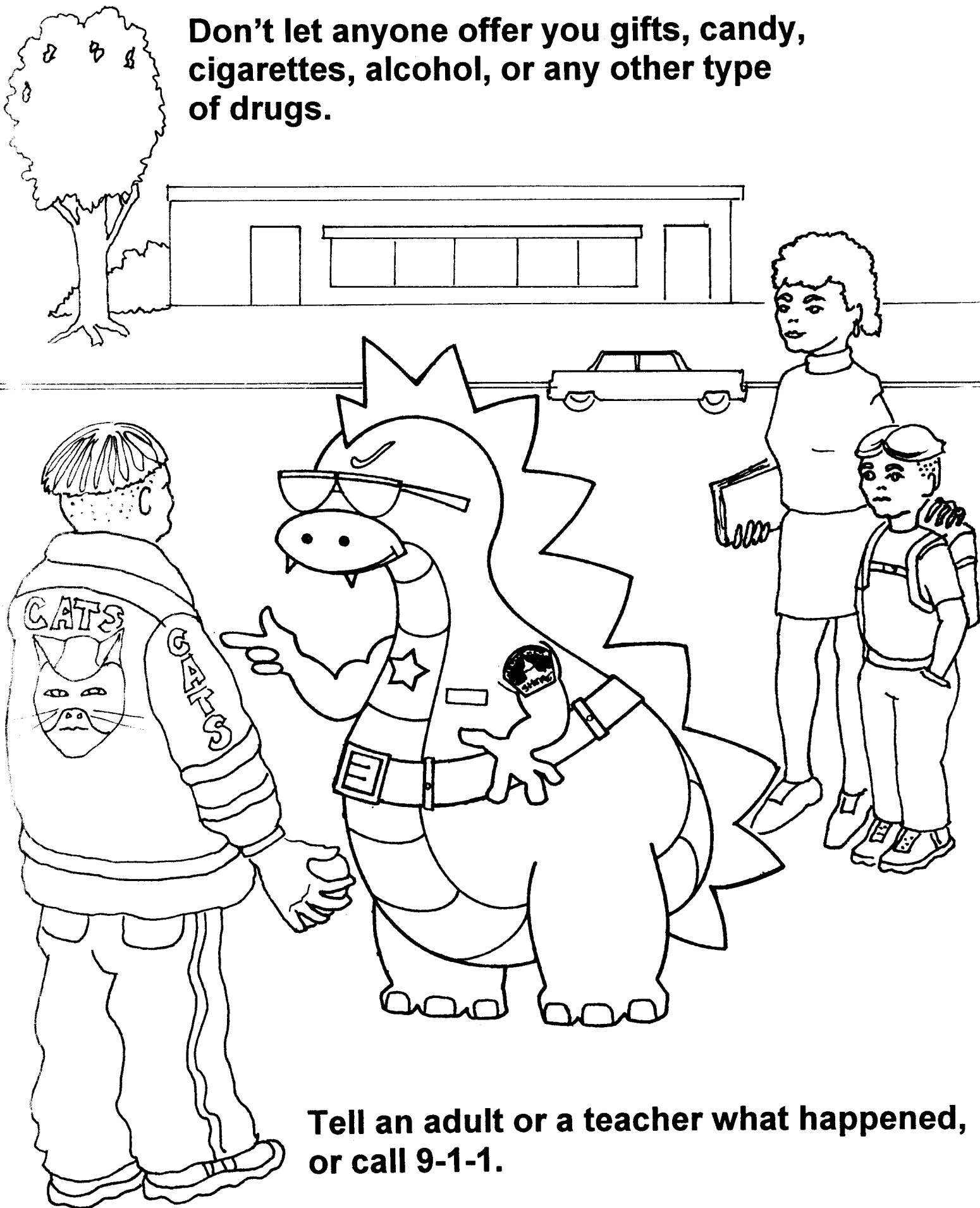

Tell an adult or a teacher what happened, or call 9-1-1.

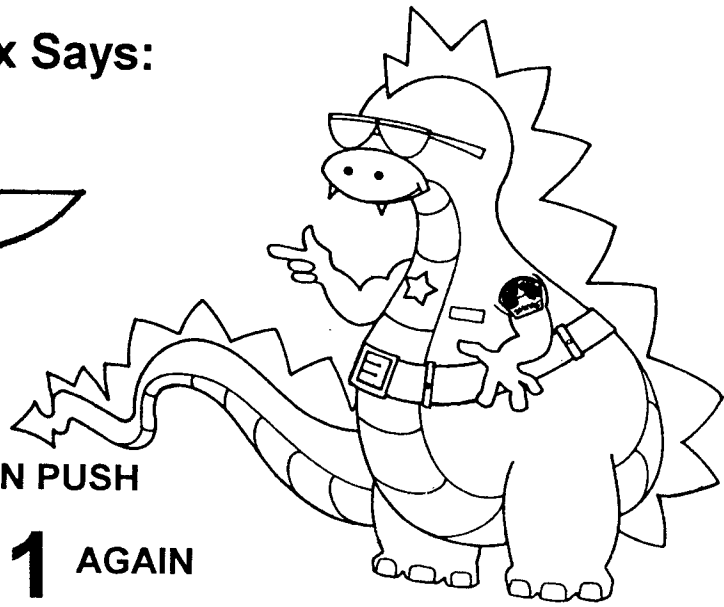
SAFETY AT PLAY

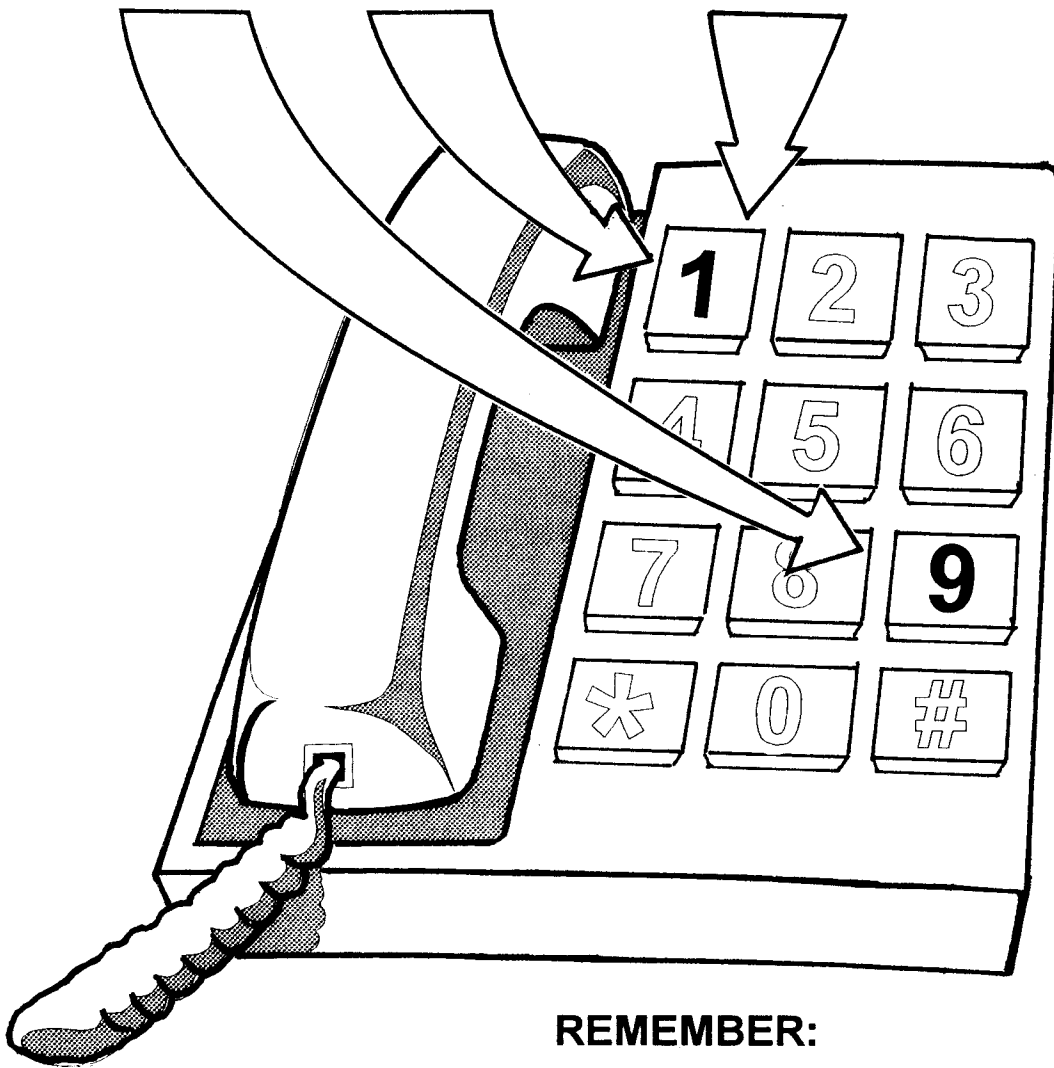
