

**BICYCLE PATROL - ADVANCED**

POST Plan IV 2310-23840

The Training Division of the Sacramento County Sheriff's Department is presenting a forty (40) hour, POST certified course on Advanced Bicycle Patrol operations. This course will introduce bicycle patrol officers to a variety of new challenges; bicycle defensive tactics, bicycle crowd management training for large crowds, demonstrations, civil disobedience, and riot control.

Payment is due by the first day of class. This department's cancellation policy requires a two (2) week notice prior to the class start date. No-shows and those canceling with less than two weeks notice will be charged the full tuition fee if no replacement student is found. NOTE: Classes may be cancelled at any time if the minimum enrollment is not attained. You will be notified of any changes.

Fitness: This class is very physically demanding. All participants should be able to ride 10 miles in less than 50 minutes. Training rides can last over 2 hours.

Attire: **All personnel shall display department or agency identification.**
Students attending this course are expected to dress appropriately: Suitable clothing for operating a bicycle including off-road training, rain, hot, or cold weather. Bike Patrol uniform required on Day 5.

Equipment: Suitable patrol mountain bike, headlamps, tail lamp, spare tube and tire patch kit, bicycle tire, pump, armor vest, helmet, eye protection, toe clips or clipless pedals, gun belt, baton, gloves. **Riot gear:** Helmet, gas mask, etc. **OPTIONAL:** Off-road specific tires for off-road training & first aid kit.

To Pass Class: Complete: 20-30 miles of off-road riding, 40-50 miles of riding on paved roads, a timed obstacle course, a 32 mile nighttime skills ride, qualify on the bicycle range course with a score of 80% or better, pass a written exam with a score of 70% or better.
