The Training Division of the Sacramento County Sheriff's Department is presenting a forty (40) hour, POST certified course on Basic Police Bicycle Patrol operations. This course will prepare those law enforcement personnel who are assigned as bicycle patrol officers to safely operate their bicycle in a bicycle patrol environment under normal and emergency situations. Prerequisite: Student must have successfully completed a POST/STC/ or C-POST certified academy and currently be employed by a law enforcement agency.

Payment is due by the first day of class. This department's cancellation policy requires a two (2) week notice prior to the class start date. No-shows and those canceling with less than two weeks notice will be charged the full tuition fee if no replacement student is found. NOTE: Classes may be cancelled at any time if the minimum enrollment is not attained. You will be notified of any changes.

Fitness: This class is very physically demanding. All participants should be able to ride 10 miles in less than 50 minutes. Training rides can last over 2 hours.

Attire: **All personnel shall display department or agency identification.**
Students attending this course are expected to dress appropriately: Suitable clothing for operating a bicycle (padded bike shorts, etc.), Day 1-4 wear appropriate casual riding attire. Day 5 wear your uniform.

Equipment: Suitable Patrol Mountain Bike – bikes will be inspected. Gun belt, baton, toe clips, cups or clipless pedals, gloves, water bottle, helmet, eye protection, armor (vest), Uniform for one ride, duty handgun, 30 rounds.
