

**COLLAPSIBLE BATON**

The Training Division of the Sacramento County Sheriff's Department is presenting a four (4) hour POST/STC certified course on the Collapsible Baton. The course consists of instruction and practical exercises, focused on the specific use and application of the collapsible baton and how the operation and use of the collapsible baton differs from the standard police baton. Students will demonstrate, through a written examination, knowledge of the legal aspects regarding use of the baton, review SSD policy regarding the baton, and demonstrate their ability to hit the proper strike zones on a suspect.
