DRIVER TRAINING - CIVILIAN

The Training Division of the Sacramento County Sheriff's Department, in conjunction with the Sacramento Regional Driver Training Facility, is presenting an eight (8) hour, Civilian Driver Training class. This class is for personnel who **frequently must drive in the normal course of their employment**. The program is primarily "hands on" augmented with in-class material, and includes a written and a driving evaluation.

INSTRUCTION INCLUDES:

- **Accident Avoidance:** learning to master weight transfer and smooth steering
- **ABS Braking:** braking and directional control with Anti-Lock Braking Systems
- **Precision Vehicle Placement:** necessary techniques for close proximity movement
- **Skid Pan:** learning skid recovery on a flooded, polished concrete pad

Eligible: **Non-sworn County of Sacramento civilian employees in good health, with good back, neck and shoulder flexibility. Exercises are motion intensive!**

Date/Time: Wednesdays at **7:00 AM sharp**. Because classes begin immediately, and in consideration of the other students, please be on time.

Fee: **\$342.00** (.25 credits) **Make checks payable to SSDTTF.**
Payment is due on the day of class. Cancellation policy requires a **two (2) week** notice **prior** to the class start date. No-shows and those canceling with less than two weeks notice will be charged the full tuition fee if no replacement student is found. There is no charge for County of Sacramento non-enterprise employees.

Attire: We drive rain or shine; dress sensibly and appropriately for the weather.
