

**FIREARMS: LONG RIFLE INSTRUCTOR****(Law Enforcement Rifle Instructor)**

The Training Division of the Sacramento County Sheriff's Department is presenting a forty (40) hour, POST certified course, Rifle Instructor for the AR-15/M-16 type weapon.

Description: This course consists of instruction and practical exercises focused on the specific needs of the rifle instructor, the use and application of the rifle as it pertains to law enforcement and the skills to instruct others in its use and maintenance. The instructor/students will demonstrate the following: Knowledge of policy and procedures guideline for the patrol rifle officer, Knowledge of tactical employment of the rifle, Proper disassembly, assembly and cleaning of the weapon, Proper zeroing techniques of the weapon, Proficiency with the weapon by successfully completing position and movement courses.

No-shows and those canceling with less than two weeks notice will be charged the full tuition fee if no replacement student is found. NOTE: Classes may be cancelled at any time if the minimum enrollment is not attained. You will be notified of any changes.

Equipment: AR-15/M16 type rifle, 500 rounds, Rifle service ammo, 3 magazines 20/30 round capacity for rifle, Rifle tactical over-the-top sling, Duty handgun with 3 magazines, Duty gun belt & flashlight, 100 rounds handgun service ammo, Weapon carry case, Weapon cleaning equipment, Note taking materials, Range clothing, Tactical uniform, Hat, Eye/ear protection, Ballistic vest, Sunscreen and Water. Optional: Knee/elbow pads, Spotting scope or binoculars, ground cover.
