



**TACTICAL LOW-LIGHT
(HANDGUN TACTICAL LIGHT)**

The Training Division of the Sacramento County Sheriff's Department is presenting an eight (8) hour, POST certified Tactical Low-Light course on the use of the handgun tactical light.

Students attending this course will learn legal aspects and advantages of carrying a duty weapon equipped with a tactical light. The course topics include flashlight and tactical light considerations as well as low-light training principles and tactics. This course includes practical exercises. Satisfactory completion of a qualifications course and demonstration of safe weapons handling is required.
