Arrest/Control Techniques & Three-Man Bump Tactics
Emergency Medical Treatment**

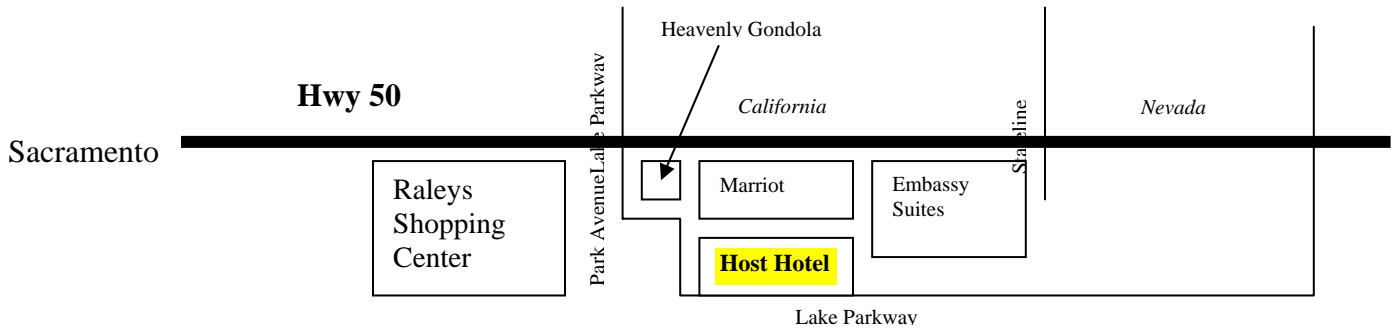

Important Registration Information!

Dates and Times: All Registration will occur between 1400-1700 hours the day **before** your class begins, **Monday, June 22, 2009**. Registration will be held at the host hotel, **Forest Suites Resort**, One Lake Parkway, South Lake Tahoe.



Training site: “Round Hill Resort”, U.S.F.S. Training Facility.
From Stateline (Harrah’s Hotel/Casino in South Lake Tahoe) take Highway 50 eastbound past the Round Hill Plaza Shopping Center. Travel approximately ¼ mile further on Highway 50, past the shopping center, and turn left at the Round Hill Resort entrance. Follow the road to the training site.

The site has limited parking. Carpooling from your hotel or the Round Hill Shopping Center area is recommended.

Required Equipment: Unless otherwise indicated, the following is a **mandatory** list of equipment that each student shall bring with them.

1. The Narcotics Tactical Entry T-shirt you’re given at Registration, at the host hotel, the afternoon/evening before your training class begins. Host hotel is the Forest Inn Suites, located at One Lake Parkway, SLT, (800)822-5950 (530)541-6655 (west of Embassy Suites).
2. Raid gear, radio, battery and charger, flashlight, cuffs, cuff key, raid jackets/vests, etc. **(All items that you would normally take with you during a raid.)**
3. Comfortable clothing that can get dirty as several of the scenarios require officers to enter dusty, damp buildings. The weather in the mountains is changeable, so carry appropriate clothing for a wide variety of weather. You could need rain or cold-weather gear.
4. **Bring your own personal clear eye protection.** Ear protection will be provided. Boots or tennis shoes. This facility is in the mountains and there are many areas where there are uneven ground and granite boulders.
5. Folding Chair for your comfort. Notebook, pen and personal snacks (optional).

NOTE: THERE WILL BE NO WEAPONS, MAGAZINES OR AMMUNITIONS ALLOWED ON THE SITE. SECURE THEM IN TRUNKS OR OTHER SAFE LOCATION.
