## ADULT CORRECTIONS: SUPPLEMENTAL CORE COURSE JAIL OPERATIONS

The Training Division of the Sacramento County Sheriff's Department is presenting a 70 hour, Adult Corrections: Supplemental Core Course. This course is certified by the Standards and Training for Corrections Unit of the California Board of Corrections. This course meets the Title 15 Core Training requirement for all Peace Officers assigned to work in a custody setting. Topics include:

**California Criminal Justice Orientation  
Codes, Statutes, and Legal Documents  
Booking, Receiving, Classification, and Release  
Security, Contraband, Evidence, and Mail  
Inmate and Inmate Worker Supervision & Interpersonal communication  
Psychological, Physical Health, Commissary, Supplies and Visits  
Transportation Outside the Facility  
Emergency Procedures**

Payment is due by the first day of class. This department's cancellation policy requires a two (2) week notice prior to the class start date. NOTE: Classes may be cancelled at any time if the minimum enrollment is not attained. You will be notified of any changes.

**Attire:** All personnel shall display department identification while located at the correctional center. No firearms allowed in the facility. Please park your vehicles in the "public lot". Non-sworn students shall check-in with correctional center registration staff for temporary identification. Students attending this course are expected to dress appropriately: Shirt with collar. Jeans must be neat, clean, and in good condition. No shorts, thong type shoes (flip-flops), beach wear or sweat pants.
