This course will prepare those law enforcement personnel who are assigned as bicycle patrol officers to safely operate their bicycle in a bicycle patrol environment under normal and emergency situations. Prerequisite: Student must have successfully completed a POST/STC/ or C-POST certified academy and currently be employed by a law enforcement agency.

Payment is due by the first day of class. This department's cancellation policy requires a two (2) week notice prior to the class start date. No-shows and those canceling with less than two weeks notice will be charged the full tuition fee if no replacement student is found. NOTE: Classes may be cancelled at any time if the minimum enrollment is not attained. You will be notified of any changes.

Fitness: This class is very physically demanding. All participants should be able to ride 10 miles in less than 50 minutes. Training rides can last over 2 hours. In preparation for this class, we recommend students condition at least one month in advance.

Attire: **All personnel shall display department or agency identification.**
Students attending this course are expected to dress appropriately for classroom instruction and for operating a bicycle (padded bike shorts, etc.).
Day 1: Classroom attire. Days 2-4: Wear appropriate casual riding attire. Day 5: Wear your department bicycle patrol uniform. **Bring water bottles.**

Equipment: Patrol Mountain Bike – Bikes will be inspected for proper shocks, foot retention pedals (baskets are recommended), brakes and ride worthiness. Gun belt, gloves, spare tube, tire patch kit, bicycle tire, pump, water bottle, helmet, eye protection, armor (vest), duty handgun and 50 rounds will be required to complete the course.
