The Training Bureau of the Sacramento County Sheriff's Office (SSO) is presenting an eight (8) hour, POST certified Tactical Low-Light course on the use of the handgun tactical light. ***This course fulfills the Perishable Skills Program (PSP), Category 1, Tactical Firearms requirements.***

Students attending this course will learn legal aspects and advantages of carrying a duty weapon equipped with a tactical light. The course topics include flashlight and tactical light considerations as well as low-light training principles and tactics. This course includes practical exercises. Satisfactory completion of a qualifications course and demonstration of safe weapons handling is required.

- Equipment:** Duty handgun affixed with an approved tactical light and three (3) magazines, 300 rounds of handgun service ammo, Duty flashlight, Ballistic vest, Note pad, and pen/pencil, Clothing suited to strenuous activity as well as being seasonally appropriate, Rain gear / cold weather gear (seasonal), Ear pro (electronic preferred) / Eye pro, Baseball style hat recommended, Proper belt to support equipment, Tools that work on your weapon, Weapons lube, Water hydrating device, Knee and elbow pads (optional), Gloves (optional).
