TACTICAL RIFLE ADVANCED (4-day)

The Training Bureau of the Sacramento County Sheriff's Office is presenting a 32-hour POST certified course, Tactical Rifle Advanced, on the Law Enforcement Rifle. *This course fulfills the Perishable Skills Program (PSP), Category 1, Tactical Firearms requirements.*

Students attending this course will enhance their skills using the rifle during law enforcement deployment, proper use of cover, rapid movement and target engagements. Students must successfully complete a live fire test within 70 seconds in order to pass this class.

<u>Live fire test times:</u> 60.01 seconds or more = Intermediate Level Certification

50.01 – 60.00 seconds = Advanced Level Certification 50.00 seconds or less = Advanced Plus Level Certification Dimlight 60 seconds or less = Advanced Plus Level Certification

Successful completion, at an Advanced Level, of the Tactical Rifle Advanced (1-day) is a requirement for attendance in this class.

This course is very physically demanding. It is highly recommended that officers with preexisting injuries not attend.
