

**FIREARMS: TACTICAL RIFLE INSTRUCTOR**

POST Plan IV 2310-32112

The Training Bureau of the Sacramento County Sheriff's Office is presenting a forty (40) hour, POST certified course, Rifle Instructor for the AR-15/M-16 type weapon.

Description: This course consists of instruction and practical exercises focused on the specific needs of the rifle instructor, the use and application of the rifle as it pertains to law enforcement, and the skills to instruct others in its use and maintenance. The instructor/students will demonstrate the following: how to properly format and deliver an expanded course outline, lesson plan, courses of fire and safety plan.

Prerequisite: Student must have successfully completed a POST certified academy, Firearms Instructor Course, a tactical rifle user course and must currently be employed by a law enforcement agency.

(SSO students will be charged an additional \$139.50 for ammunition. SSO students do not need to bring ammunition to the range.)

Payment is due by the first day of class. This department's cancellation policy requires a two (2) week notice prior to the class start date. No-shows and those canceling with less than two weeks notice will be charged the full tuition fee if no replacement student is found. NOTE: Classes may be cancelled at any time if the minimum enrollment is not attained. You will be notified of any changes.
