

**LESS LETHAL WEAPON / MUNITIONS**

The Training Bureau of the Sacramento County Sheriff's Office is presenting a four (4) hour, POST/STC certified course, Less Lethal Weapon. The purpose of this course is to familiarize officers with the nomenclature, functioning and cleaning of the 40mm Launcher and Remington 870 Less Lethal Shotgun as well as the Sheriff's Office policies regarding its use. Officers will be instructed in the selection of proper target areas for this weapon and the distance restriction on some ammunition types. ***This course fulfills the Perishable Skills Program (PSP), Category 1, Tactical Firearms requirements.***

**Prerequisite:** Student must have successfully completed a POST/STC/ or C-POST certified academy and must currently be employed by a law enforcement agency.

Students attending this course are expected to dress appropriately. No shorts, thong type shoes (flip-flops), beach wear or sweat pants. Clothing capable of withstanding outside activity and foul weather gear needed.
