**BASIC MOTORCYCLE TRAINING
POST – 80hrs #2310-32550**

The Training Bureau of the Sacramento County Sheriff's Office presents an eighty (80) hour, two-week, POST certified, Basic Motorcycle Training Course. This course is designed for departments/officers riding BMW, Harley Davidson, Honda, or Kawasaki motorcycles. Departments are required to send officers with department training bikes for the on-site training and full dresser bikes for the off-site rides or only full dresser bikes. The program is primarily "hands-on" training augmented with in-class material. Topics include:

Both In-Class & Hands-On Training:

Basic Braking, Braking Concepts, Figure 8 and Circles, Off-set 90 (flat and incline), Intersection, Keyhole, Short Cones, 40 Deceleration (braking), Incline Pullouts, Cone Pattern One, Two, Three, 180 Deceleration (braking & turning), 30 MPH Cone Weave, Incline Figure 8, Slow Ride, Dirt Ride, Incline Start & Stop U-Turn, Apexing, The "HURT" Study (Motorcycle Collision Data), Car Stops and Firearms.
