FIREARMS/SECONDARY WEAPON (BACK-UP)

The Training and Education Bureau of the Sacramento County Sheriff's Office is presenting an eight (8) hour, POST certified CONCEALED CARRY and SECONDARY WEAPONS course. Students attending this class will learn practical applications for deploying a concealed handgun both on and off duty. The course topics include weapon and ammunition selection, equipment considerations, use of cover and concealment, deployment techniques, various shooting positions, one-handed manipulation, and tactics using practical exercises and applications. *This course fulfills the Perishable Skills Program (PSP), Category 1, Tactical Firearms requirements.*

Prerequisite:	Student must have successfully completed a POST certified academy and currently be employed by a law enforcement agency.

	**Due to unforeseen circumstances, outside agency students are required to supply their own ammunition. <u>Ammunition will not be made available for non-SSO students.</u> **SSO students will be charged an additional fee of \$50.00 for ammunition and do not need to bring ammunition to the range. **Cost of tuition and ammunition subject to change.
	Payment is due by the first day of class. Cancellation policy requires a two (2) week notice prior to the class start date. No-shows and those canceling with less than two weeks' notice will be charged the full tuition fee if no replacement student is found. NOTE: Classes may be cancelled at any time if the minimum enrollment is not attained.
Equipment:	Duty belt with duty handgun and three (3) magazines, vest holster or ankle holster for secondary weapon (hideout weapon) with secondary weapon (hideout weapon) with 50 rounds of handgun service ammo, 200 rounds of service ammo for the secondary weapon (hideout weapon), eye/ear protection, ballistic vest, range clothing, tactical uniform, hat, sunscreen, water, and note taking materials. Additional requirements for the class include: A SERVICABLE FIREARM WITH A <u>STOCK TRIGGER</u> AND 3 MAGAZINES, INSIDE OR OUTSIDE THE WAISTBAND HOLSTER AND CLOTHING CONDUCIVE FOR CONCEALING A FIREARM UPON THE BODY. **NO shorts or sandals allowed for Firearms Training Classes.
