The Training and Education Bureau of the Sacramento County Sheriff's Office is presenting a sixteen (16) hour, POST and STC certified TACTICAL HANDGUN Course. *This course fulfills the Perishable Skills Program (PSP), Category 1, Tactical Firearms requirements.*

Students attending this class will learn practical applications for deploying the handgun in tactical and emergency situations. Additionally, students will learn officer survival tactics when shooting in unconventional positions. The course topics include transitioning drills, disabled hand considerations, different types of reloads and shooting on the move using practical exercises and applications.

**Due to ammunition supply issues outside agency students are required to supply their own ammunition. <u>Ammunition will not be made available for non-SSO students</u>. **SSO students will be charged an additional fee of \$400.00 for ammunition and do not need to bring ammunition to the range.

Payment is due by the first day of class. Cancellation policy requires a two (2) week notice prior to the class start date. No-shows and those canceling with less than two weeks' notice will be charged the full tuition fee if no replacement student is found. NOTE:

Equipment: Duty handgun and three (3) magazines, 2000 rounds of handgun service ammo, ballistic

vest, note pad, and pen/pencil, clothing suited to strenuous activity as well as being seasonally appropriate, rain gear / cold weather gear (seasonal), ear pro (electronic preferred) / eye pro, baseball style hat recommended, proper belt to support equipment, tools that work on your weapon, weapons lube, water hydrating device, knee and elbow pads (optional), gloves (optional). **No shorts or sandals allowed for Firearms Training
