## **TACTICAL RIFLE ADVANCED (4-Day)**

The Training Bureau of the Sacramento County Sheriff's Office is presenting a 32-hour POST certified course, TACTICAL RIFLE ADVANCED, on the Law Enforcement Rifle. ***This course fulfills the Perishable Skills Program (PSP), Category 1, Tactical Firearms requirements.***

Students attending this course will enhance their skills using the rifle during law enforcement deployment, proper use of cover, rapid movement and target engagements. Students must successfully complete a live fire test within 70 seconds in order to pass this class.

Live fire test times:

- 60.01 seconds or more = Intermediate Level Certification
- 50.01 – 60.00 seconds = Advanced Level Certification
- 50.00 seconds or less = Advanced Plus Level Certification
- Dimlight 60 seconds or less = Advanced Plus Level Certification

***This course is very physically demanding. It is highly recommended that officers with pre-existing injuries not attend.***

**Prerequisite:** Student must have successfully completed a POST/STC/ or C-POST certified academy, completed a basic Tactical Rifle course and currently be employed by a law enforcement agency

**\*\*Due to ammunition supply issues outside agency students are required to supply their own ammunition. Ammunition will not be made available for non-SSO students.**

**\*\*SSO students will be charged an additional fee of \$720.00 for ammunition and do not need to bring ammunition to the range.**

**\*\*Cost of tuition and ammunition subject to change.**

Payment is due by the first day of class. Cancellation policy requires a two (2) week notice prior to the class start date. No-shows and those canceling with less than two weeks' notice will be charged the full tuition fee if no replacement student is found. NOTE: Classes may be cancelled at any time if the minimum enrollment is not attained.

**Equipment:** **Gloves are highly recommended,** AR-15/M16 type rifle w/3 30 round magazines, 2000 rounds .223 FMJ ammo, 100 rounds handgun service ammo, sling, duty handgun, duty belt, eye/ear protection, ballistic vest, clothing suited to strenuous activity as well as being seasonally appropriate, rain gear/cold weather gear (seasonal), hat, sunscreen, water hydrating device, knee and elbow pads (optional), and note taking materials. \*\*No shorts or sandals allowed for Firearms Training Classes.
