## **TACTICAL LOW-LIGHT (HANDGUN TACTICAL LIGHT)**

The Training Bureau of the Sacramento County Sheriff's Office is presenting an eight (8) hour, POST certified TACTICAL LOW LIGHT course on the use of the handgun tactical light. ***This course fulfills the Perishable Skills Program (PSP), Category 1, Tactical Firearms requirements.***

Students attending this course will learn legal aspects and advantages of carrying a duty weapon equipped with a tactical light. The course topics include flashlight and tactical light considerations as well as low-light training principles and tactics. This course includes practical exercises. Satisfactory completion of a qualifications course and demonstration of safe weapons handling is required.

**Prerequisite:** Student must have successfully completed a POST/STC or C-POST certified academy and currently be employed by a law enforcement agency.

***\*\*Due to ammunition supply issues outside agency students are required to supply their own ammunition. Ammunition will not be made available for non-SSO students.***

***\*\*SSO students will be charged an additional fee of \$40.00 for ammunition and do not need to bring ammunition to the range.***

***\*\*Cost of tuition and ammunition subject to change.***

Payment is due by the first day of class. Cancellation policy requires a two (2) week notice prior to the class start date. No-shows and those canceling with less than two weeks' notice will be charged the full tuition fee if no replacement student is found. NOTE: Classes may be cancelled at any time if the minimum enrollment is not attained.

**Equipment:** Duty handgun affixed with an approved tactical light and three (3) magazines, 200 rounds of handgun service ammo, duty flashlight, ballistic vest, note pad, and pen/pencil, clothing suited to strenuous activity as well as being seasonally appropriate, rain gear / cold weather gear (seasonal), ear pro (electronic preferred) / eye pro, baseball style hat recommended, proper belt to support equipment, tools that work on your weapon, weapons lube, water hydrating device, knee and elbow pads (optional), gloves (optional). ***\*\*No shorts or sandals allowed for Firearms Training Classes.***
