CalFresh: The CalFresh Program issues monthly electronic benefits to low-income individuals and families who meet federal income eligibility rules that can be used to buy most foods at many markets, farmers' markets, and food stores.

CalWORKS: CalWORKs is a cash aid program for low income families to meet their basic needs. It also provides education, employment, and training programs to help families get jobs and move towards self-sufficiency.

Medi-Cal: Medi-Cal is California's Medicaid health care program. This program pays for a variety of medical services for children and adults with limited income and resources. Provides no-cost or low-cost health coverage for adults who are aged (65 years or older), blind, disabled,

pregnant, or in a long-term facility; for children who are under 21 years of age; or for families with children who receive CalWORKs and/or are deprived of support or care because at least one of their parents is unemployed/underemployed, absent, deceased, or incapacitated.

General Assistance: Provides assistance to all eligible indigent residents of Sacramento County who are at least eighteen years of age, unemployed or verified unemployable and who have no other means of support. It is intended to provide short-term financial assistance and limited services that will enable a recipient either to find employment or to obtain support from another source.






